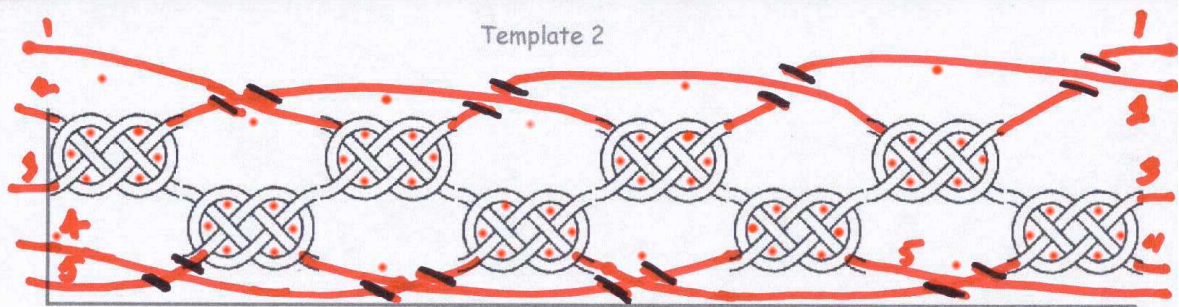


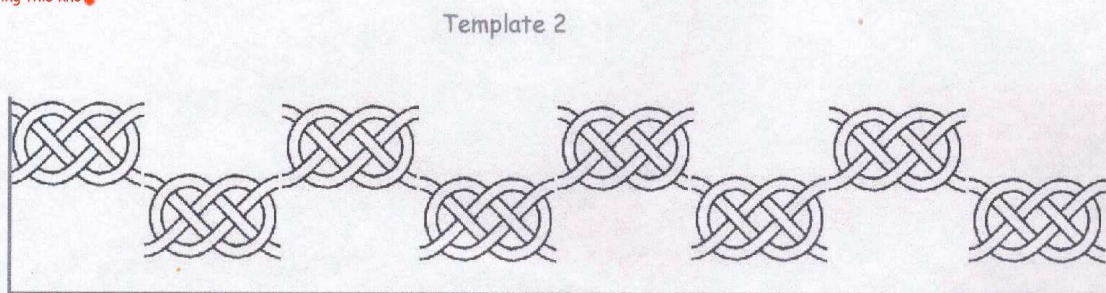

The 2 knots on the cardboard tube are not the same knot so the bottom knot only adds confusion to the equation. Without a clear picture I fear I will not be able to duplicate the knot. The trick to using a template like this you can print it out and put it around a tube and use it to pin your work in place.  
Pin placement is really important on this knot, it needs lots of them.  
Place a pin in all of the spots marked with a dot and you will have better luck tying this knot.
